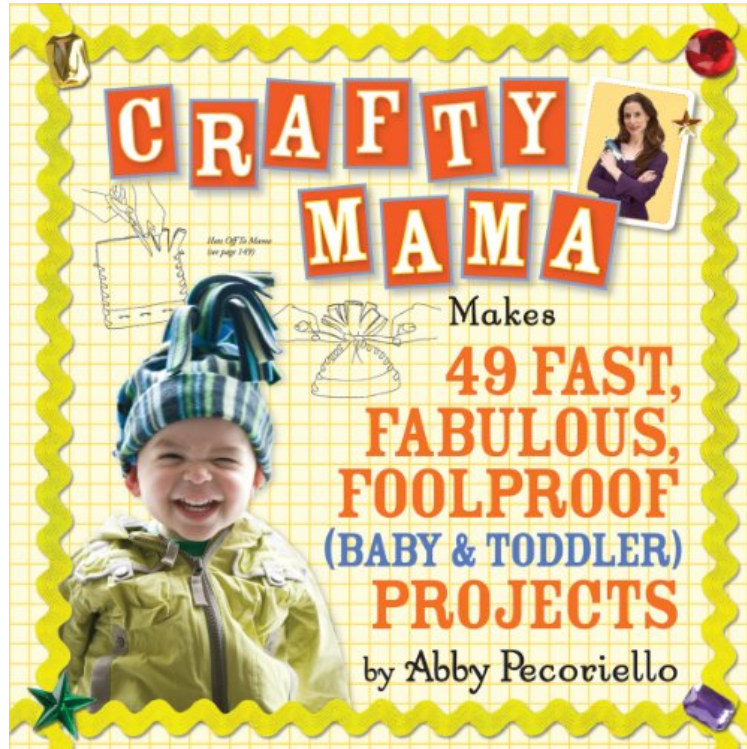

So far I've only made the fleece car seat cover, and it worked well. One observation: The author carefully keeps all of her projects "Sew-free," and I understand her reasoning. The projects are designed to be done by "mommy groups" and by people with minimal time and crafting experience. Still, some of the

projects may actually be simpler, not to mention sturdier, with some sewing. I went ahead and used my sewing machine on the car seat cover instead of trusting fabric glue to hold up in the wash.
