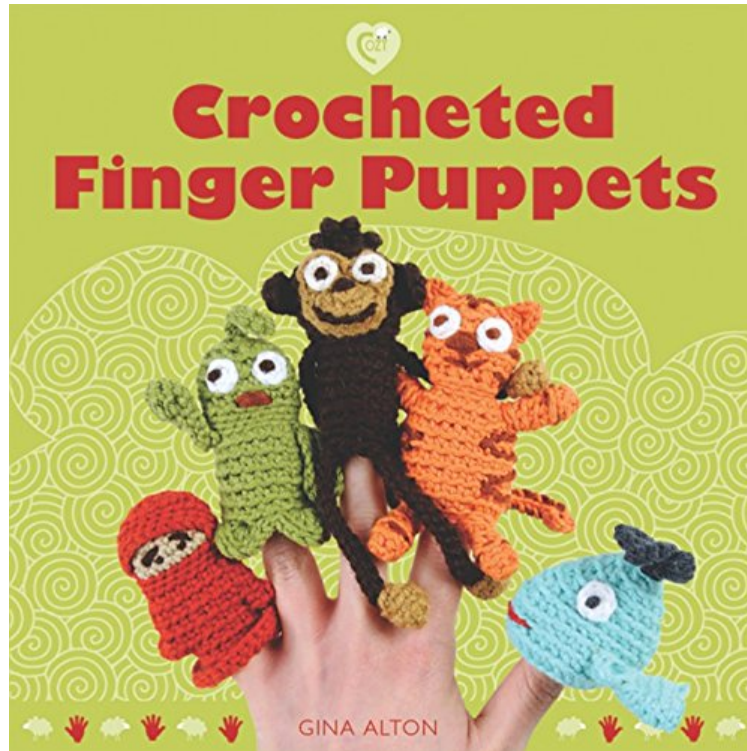

Finger puppets are a great way to entertain kids on a rainy day, and they make adorable gifts, too. And crocheters will have as much fun making these whimsical little characters as kids will have playing with them. The 30 projects are divided into three child-friendly themes: Wild Animals, such as the Lion, Monkey, and Penguin; Under the Sea, featuring Starfish, Crab, and a pretty Mermaid; and Outer Space, starring a cast of green Martians, a bug-eyed Alien, and the Robot. All the projects come with easy-to-follow patterns, and there's a section on basic crochet techniques for newcomers or those needing a refresher.
