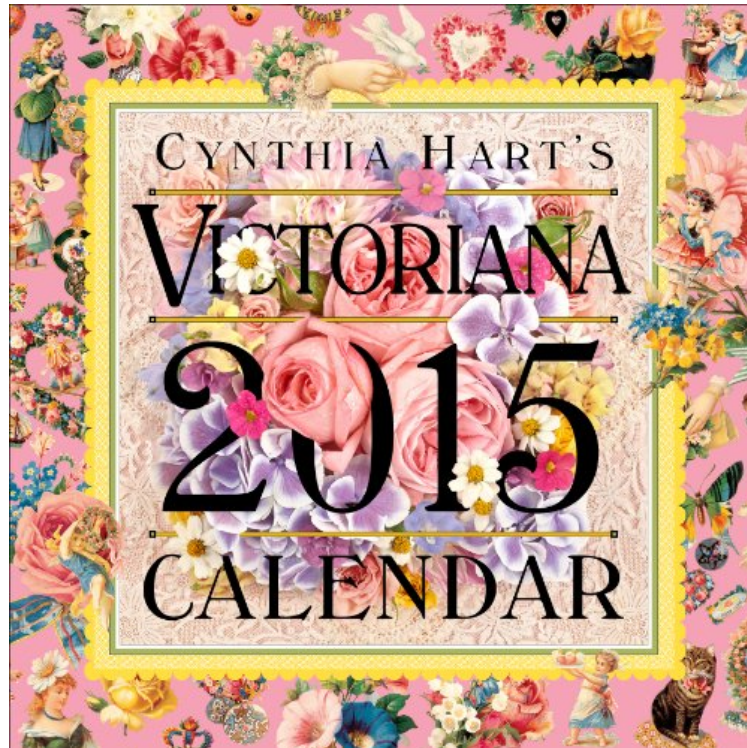

Schoonover For over twenty-five years I have purchased this beautiful calendar and I now routinely buy two every autumn for my mother and my self. Like always the pages for each each of the twelve months is stuffed with a variety of Victoriana images organized by seasonal theme. A brief description of each month's illustrations follows: January - A bevy of beautiful girls accented by richly colored flowers are featured. The only obvious nod to the month on this one is a small champagne bottle and glass to celebrate the new year. February - Some elf like creatures are forging the chains on hearts surrounded by lots of traditional cupids, hearts, and other lovely objects from old Valentines. March - Girls are out gathering flowers even though the trees are still bare which seems very appropriate for this winter/spring transition month. Lots of sweet girls in bonnets are shown as well. April - Easter comes at the beginning of the month this year and a little girl with a lily and a new outfit is the centerpiece plus lots of bunnies, chicks and so forth to celebrate the first days of real spring. May - Cute babies abound for the month of Mother's Da. June - This month is for lots of roses, children, couples and a bride. July - There's a horse race theme that I don't remember ever being used in the calendar in the past. August - This especially beautiful month has a woman and children in an idyllic scene with a rowboat surrounded by swans as its centerpiece. Other dreamy summer motifs are also featured. September - A variety of charming dogs, children and chrysanthemums celebrate the month when

autumn begins. October - This month is taken over by black cats with some accompanying orange symbols of Halloween. November - Thanksgiving month is devoted to a celebration of the comforts of home and heart. December - Of course there are Santas as well as other holidays symbols. The feature Santa is rather slender and carries a basket of toys rather than a bag. Major holidays are marked on the calendar. There is a two page month by month "Notes On The Ephmera Collectibles for those who want to know more about the individual images used. And four note cards and a standup year at a glance calendar are also included. 3 of 3 people found the following review helpful. Specifically, it is missing the 12 holes -- one per page -- needed to hang the calendar. Please send the replacement holes as soon as possible. Thank you. In all seriousness, I buy this every year for my mother. She loves it, and 2015 is no exception. Very pretty artwork, as always. It really was missing the hole, however, giving no way to hang the calendar. I'm guessing this is a rare manufacturing problem since other reviews don't mention it, but I'm taking off one star for this defect. Should this happen to you, too, it's easy to fix with a drill. This calendar is so disappointing I did not hang it up. There was no magic on her pages. A cheaper company? No hole to hang. Cheap paper. If it is about rising costs to produce the calendars I would gladly pay a few dollars more if we could again enjoy her calendars like those purchased in the past.
