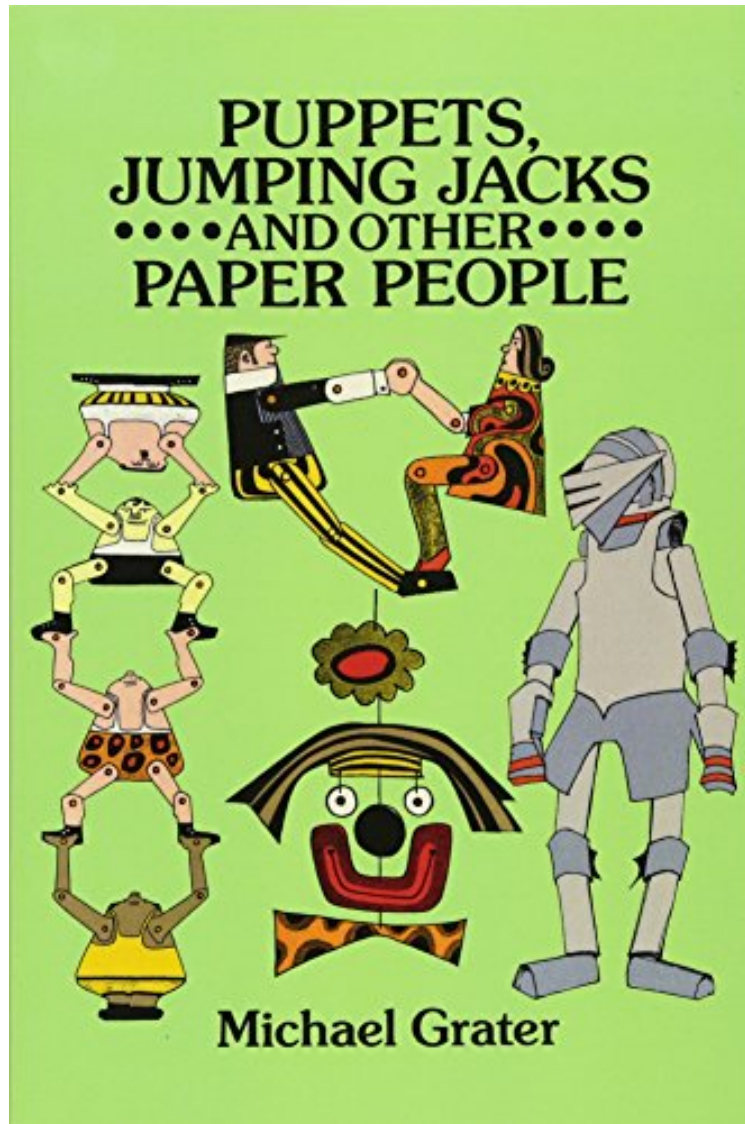

Recycled newspapers, aluminum foil, giftwrap, cardboard, and other salvaged papers may be used in many of the projects. Only a few simple tools and supplies are needed scissors, glue, a stapler, crayons, felt-tip pens, and watercolors or poster paints. Clearly illustrated step-by-step instructions enable papercraft enthusiasts including children and novices to make these paper toys: puppets, jumping jacks, acrobats, angels, clowns, spinning and swinging figures, funny faces, masks, and more.
