One of the most unique quilts is "Antlers" where Ms. Purvis uses the wrong side of the fabric to help create a "bend" in the "antlers." It's wonderful! I also love the brief segment on the inspiration for the patterns and the little blurbs before each quilt.The cutting instructions are lengthy so I would place this in a more advanced beginner/intermediate category as organization and precise piecing are important with most, if not all, of the designs.The only negative with this book is that you never see the full quilt. She does provide the block layout in its entirety but for some quilts that is not enough. I learned the hard way after my Colorblock quilt didn't piece together correctly at first--all the printed measurements for cutting are wrong!The designs are fun, and the patterns are explanatory, but it's a HUGE disappointment that there are so many errors in the printing of a pattern book--quilting is an exact science, and measurements are at the core.
