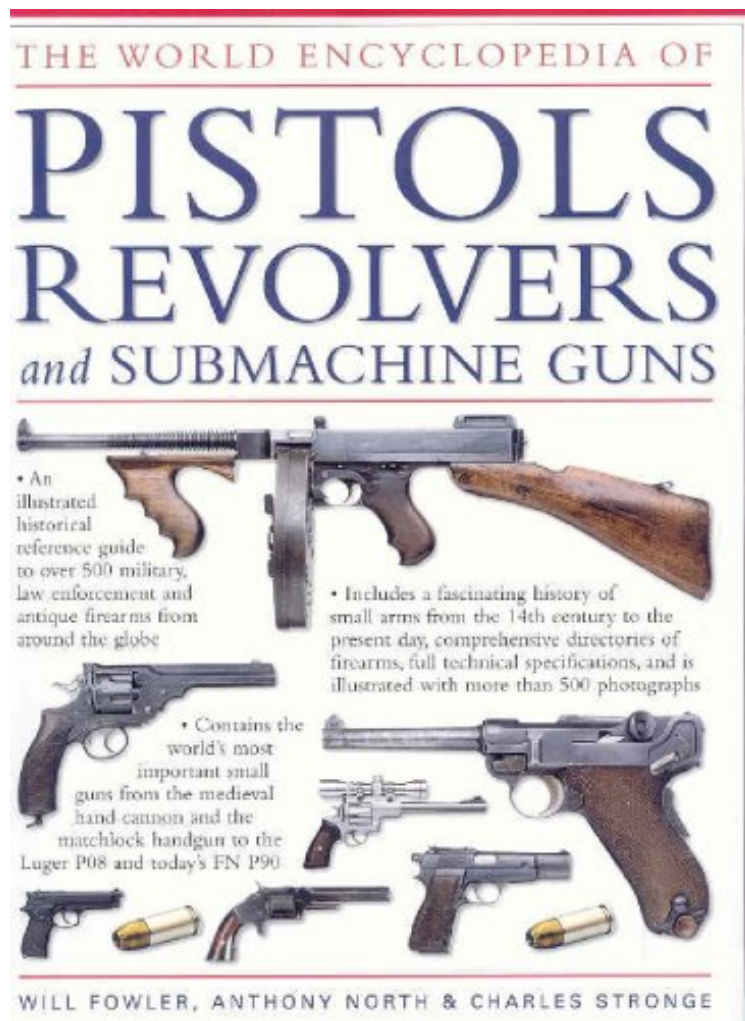

In this case, a paragraph or two on over 500 pistols, revolvers, submachine guns. Made from high gloss paper, almost every entry has a photo of the weapon, brief narrative and a few statistics about each one. Caliber, weight/length of weapon, number of rounds carried and manufacturer are included. 256 pages spell out over 500 different weapons. Authors do a good job with the space available. The same authors also wrote a larger encyclopedia with over 500 pages, as you would expect, it costs more. I'd recommend this for someone who has a passing interest in handguns, submachine guns. This is a good value for the money. It will not help you if you are a collector or want to know in depth histories of individual weapons or the history of armament companies.
